New Testament for Everyone

8 How has this all come about? You have been saved by grace, through faith! This doesn't happen on your own initiative; it's God's gift. 9 It isn't on the basis of works, so no one is able to boast.

KEY POINTS FOR STUDY & REFLECTION

- Grace is a Gift: We are saved by grace, which is a free gift from God.
- Through Faith: Our salvation comes through faith in Jesus Christ.
- Not by Works: Salvation is not something we can earn; it is given by God.

- What does it mean to you that grace is a gift from God?
- How does understanding that salvation is not earned by works impact your faith?
- How can you share the message of grace with others?
- In what ways can you live out the truth of this passage in your daily life?
